57 that no one individual can be the Chair for more than two consecutive years.

60 **to law**. Motion carried by a unanimous voice vote. **ORD.NO. 27-2024 declared and adopted.**

62 **ORDINANCE NO. 28-2024**

69 Dir. Chadock explained the intent is to renovate the Longwood Park north fields in the Fall of 2024, with
70 any delay due to scheduling or inclement weather pushing it to Spring 2025. The contractor chosen
71 demonstrated the ability to address drainage issues as well as the construction of new fields.

73 Ms. Tulley moved, second by Mr. Garvas, to **adopt ORD.NO. 28-2024 and post the same according to**
74 **law**. Motion carried by a unanimous voice vote. **ORD.NO. 28-2024 declared and adopted.**

83 Dir. Chadock reported this project is part of the planned capital program which will renovate the existing
84 pool deck in the aquatic area to coincide with the planned shutdown of the Recreation Center from May
85 27-June 9.

87 Ms. Brandt asked how long the surface should last, to which Dir. Chadock responded the rubberized pool
88 deck has a 25-year lifespan.

138 ~ Thanks to all who attended SpringFest and for staff that helped bring it to fruition. Ms. Brandt

141 ~Please do not place or leave grass clippings in the road as they can cause many problems.

142 ~The trees in treelawns are the homeowner's responsibility to maintain. While the City will help
143 manage the problem if it is a safety issue, the tree and anything else therein is the homeowner's
144 responsibility.

145 ~Residents may see what are called OUPS tickets (Ohio Utilities Protection Service). These flags
146 identify utilities for when roadwork may be done. If residents have questions they can call the
147 City, but please leave them alone.

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DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Service Department: Director Wilson – Spring cleanup dumpsters are open to residents from 8am-5pm, even on weekends, through April 28. Brush dropoff will still be available beyond that from 7:30am-4pm. To avoid confusion, there will still be a dumpster at the Service Department location after the 28th, but that is for normal use by the Service Department. Mowing and weed eating is picking up this time of year. There was a recent retirement, which means a new person will need to be hired. The new mechanic is fully on board now. Upstairs improvements at City Hall are near completion.

Ms. Brandt thanked the Service Department staff for helping clean up around SpringFest.

Engineer: Director Gigliotti – Thanks to Council for passage of the Walters Road legislation. The Ohio Public Works Commission gave the City word that it will be receiving the \$400,000 grant it applied for repaving Ledge Road. That is scheduled to take place during the Summer of 2025.

Parks and Recreation Department: – Director Chadock – Thanks to Council for approving the multipurpose fields and pool deck contracts. Thanks to all staff and volunteers at SpringFest for their flexibility in moving things around on the fly. The food truck that was scheduled this evening had to cancel due to mechanical issues. Saturday, May 18 is Family Fishing Day and the lake at Longwood Park is stocked. SummerFest will be June 7-8. The Parks and Recreation Department has been named a Gold Medal Award finalist again in 2024.

Finance Department: Director Veres – RITA refunds are being processed. July 15 is the deadline unless you have been granted an extension.

IT Department: Director Collins – 21 help desk tickets closed since the last meeting. Major projects include buttoning up the digital sign by Wendy's.

Building Department: Absent

HR Department: Director Smith – No report

Fire Department: Chief Ripley – Hydrant flushing taking place. With the nicer weather be on the lookout for bicyclists, both old and new, especially in the neighborhoods.

Police Department: Chief Yakopovich – National Telecommunications Week was a success, and the dispatchers thank those that showed their appreciation. Noah Benza will be starting as a new patrol officer on Sunday.

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE CERTAIN EQUIPMENT FOR THE CITY OF MACEDONIA SERVICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Macedonia Service Department desires to purchase one (1) new 2024 Ford F-450 Utility Trades Vehicle, with a full-height trades bed, at the anticipated cost of \$92,606.00, through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services (“DAS”) governmental cooperative purchasing program, DAS Contract No. RS1018692, Item 39AT, for the City’s Service Department; and

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase of the 2024 Ford F-450 Utility Trades Vehicle is already included within the five-year capital budget; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of all City residents to purchase the 2024 Ford F-450 Utility Trades Vehicle with full-height trades bed through the DAS cooperative purchasing program from Valley Ford Truck, Inc. and, as such, competitive bidding for this purchase need not be undertaken.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Macedonia, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council of the City of Macedonia hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement to purchase one (1) new 2024 Ford F-450 Utility Trades Vehicle from Valley Ford Truck, Inc. through the DAS cooperative purchasing program, DAS Contract #RS1018692, Item 39AT, as set forth on the documents attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is authorized to take all necessary action to complete payment for this purchase.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption by Council and signature by the Mayor or as may otherwise be provided for in law.

**CITY OF MACEDONIA
ORDINANCE NO. 34 - 2024**

**AN ORDINANCE
PROVIDING FOR A SENIOR SIDEWALK PROGRAM
FOR THE 2024 CALENDAR YEAR**

WHEREAS, Council deems it necessary and in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the senior residents of the City to provide a Senior Sidewalk Program (“Program”) in connection with the City’s existing Sidewalk Repair Program for the 2024 calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Macedonia, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the Senior Sidewalk Program is hereby and herein provided for the 2024 calendar year, within the following guidelines:

1. All applicants must be residents of the City of Macedonia;
2. All applicants must be at least 65 years old and/or disabled and have no one living within their residence capable of repairing sidewalks which they are responsible for maintaining;
3. Proofs of age and/or disability with a current physician’s statement detailing the disability are required upon application;
4. The Program will allow qualifying seniors, on a “first-come-first serve” basis, to utilize the Program to complete requisite sidewalk maintenance during the 2024 calendar year up to and until the maximum appropriated amount for the Senior Sidewalk Program is reached.
5. The income level of all applicants must not exceed 100% of the most recent HUD very low-income limit for the Akron Ohio metropolitan statistical area;
6. All applicants must provide proof of income;
7. The Mayor has the discretion under extraneous circumstances to increase the income threshold on case-by-case basis; and
8. Any and all other regulations adopted by the Administration.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Service and/or the Director of Finance is authorized to request proposals to provide this service to the City at a total cost not to exceed \$10,000, along with other usual and customary regulations.

Section 3. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to appropriate the amount of \$10,000 from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (101), and to undertake any and all additional action, in order to carry out the funding for the 2024 Senior Sidewalk Program.

Section 4. That payment through a contract awarded by the City to accomplish such services shall be provided for, up to and not to exceed the appropriated amount of \$10,000 allocated for the Senior Sidewalk Program.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 6. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
