

City of Macedonia Announces New Trash Hauling Contract

Macedonia City Council has approved a new 5-year trash and recycling service contract with Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc. This decision, made at the July 25 council meeting, will ensure continued efficient and reliable waste management for our community.

Key Details of the New Contract:

- **Effective Date:** The new contract will go into effect on December 1.
- **Service Continuity:** Residents will experience no changes in service as Kimble Recycling & Disposal will maintain the same level of service previously provided by Republic Services.
- **Pickup Days:** There will be no changes to the current trash and recycling pickup days.
- **Tote Exchange:** Details regarding the exchange of old totes for new ones will be provided in the coming months. Please stay tuned for updates.
- **Cost Efficiency:** The new contract was chosen as the lowest and best bid, ensuring that rates remain as low as possible with only a slight increase over current rates.
- **Billing:** Households will be billed \$56.85 per quarter in 2025, with slight increases in each subsequent year.
- **Senior Assistance Program:** Low-income residents aged 65 and older, as well as disabled residents, may qualify for free rubbish disposal through the city's Senior Assistance Program.
