2. P&R Master Plan

- a. What's relevant from futures growth committee plan
 - Trails, public art and beautification (section 3), gymnasium, inside track, meeting rooms, amphitheater, kids paint halls, sugarbush; water, sewer, electric, athletic courts (longwood), trails at sugarbush
- b. What should be disregarded from that plan
 - i. Ice rink, community gardens, splash pad, waterpark
- c. Current needs
 - i. Multipurpose turf field, security cameras (sugarbush), skatepark, cleaning up manor house property, sugarbush tot quads,
- d. Future potential needs
 - Dog park, outdoor workout stations, take golf course area, parking needs (all facilities), Mac Rec building sign, baseball netting
- e. Other items to take into consideration
 - i. Farmers market, remove barns, remove grindings, expanding playgrounds, more handicap parking, wildflower area, nature area, tree's homeday's and replacement tree's in parks.

3. Parks

- a. Maintenance Final preparation on mowers and purchased 2 new trimmers. Working on ballfield mounds.
- b. Projects Budgets...Field assurance program materials arrive next month. Longwood North field renovations project being bid now, due in March 28. Working to identify next tree area to be remedied, either manor house area or sugarbush entrance.

a. Programming – All spring programming is up and running. Swim lessons are moved to lap pool due to activity pool heater. Soccer 233, highest registration ever. Volleyball increasing to 6 teams. Fishing program and Longwood Lake 85 bass, 300 blue gill, and 90 hybrid blue gill.

HVAC system, tentatively preparing for install May 27 June 9, more information to come. Pool deck replacement bid out now, March 28 deadline.
