# 2. P&R Master Plan

- a. Evaluation of plans, current needs, and future A master plan typically covers a 10-year cycle. Some agencies go as far as 20. What items are reasonable to fit in during a 10-year duration? Coding below, green yes, yellow maybe, red, no.
  - i. What's relevant from futures growth committee plan
    - 1. Top Items
      - Trails usable by everyone,
        - minus portion with strollers and lack of ADA accessibility.
      - public art halls of building, trails heads, entrance to rec based on coordination more than high value budget, beautification clear sugarbush dead trees at entrance and gain plaques and story walk. New colorful bushes or trees or plants in trail entrances (section 3) (painting pots and planting flowers as joint combination)
      - need fields now, not courts as much, debate is indoor vs outdoor,
      - trails at sugarbush invest in these and fields cleaning up manor house property, Mac Rec Building Sign, baseball netting, parking
      - gymnasium absolute need courts, 3 minimum

# 2. Consideration

- gymnasium absolute need courts, 3 minimum, 6 courts possibly, inside track, meeting rooms 2-4 years for planning and budget allocations Lights and security depends on internet access,
- athletic courts (longwood) Need to see what happens with indoor courts first Current needs
