<u>Parks & Recreation Commission:</u> Ms. Brandt stated the Commission will meet next week on Wednesday, September 18 at 6pm in the Recreation Center.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

<u>Service Department</u>: Director Wilson – Brian Gregg, a new full-time employee, has been hired and has experience with various trade skills. Met with Samsar representative regarding the installation of GPS and cameras on snowplows. Leaf season kickoff is tentatively set for October 15, but new machines that were ordered have not been received yet, so will continue to use current machines. Streetlight maintenance is taking place with a push before Halloween.

Ms. Brandt noted that residents can report streetlight outages on the City website, and Dir. Wilson noted a full evaluation of streetlights recently took place so the City knows the scope of the project.

<u>Engineer</u>: Director Gigliotti – The 2024 road program is substantially complete. Walters Road is a separate, standalone contract that only has guardrail installation and painting of lines left.

Parks and Recreation Department: - Director Chadock - FallFest is September 21 from 4:30-9:30 in 105 Longwood Park; check social media for all guidelines. New fields at Longwood South are in use and the 106 107 drainage is working properly. Longwood North fields just completed this week but won't be used until next Fall. The tree project at Sugarbush Park was completed last week. 108 109 110 Finance Department: Director Veres – The Finance Committee met prior to Council this evening and went over capital items for the Police, Fire and Service Departments as well as City Hall. There will be 111 additional Finance Committee meetings a half hour prior to the Council work sessions on September 26 112 and October 24. The first reading of the 2025 budget will be held at the October 24 Council meeting to 113 allow for a third reading prior to the end of 2024. 114 115 116 IT Department: Director Collins – 43 help desk tickets closed since the last Council meeting. Major products include updating and meeting new LEADS requirements for the Police Department 117 118 119 **Building Department:** Commissioner Monaco – The sidewalk project is winding down and should be completed in a couple weeks. Agenda items for upcoming Planning Commission and BZA meetings 120 were shared, along with various small businesses moving in. Trying to get the illuminating company to 121 turn on the streetlights within the Spruce Hill development. 122 123 **HR Department**: Director Smith – Drug-free workplace and safety training is winding down. Preparing 124 125 for the annual health fair, with informational flyers going out today. Will be recognizing October as Breast Cancer Awareness Month and raising money throughout the month to donate. 126 127 128 Fire Department: Chief Ripley – EMS collections are up, with the amount collected through August 129 being what was estimated to be the total amount for the year. PUCO grants were received to pay for Fire Department and dispatch training classes. Cleveland Water inspected fire hydrants and will be replacing 130 131 many of them. If residents have landscaped around the hydrants, be aware that in the process of replacing the hydrants, landscaping could be damaged. Fire hydrants are in the right-of-way and residents are 132 133 encouraged to move any landscaping/plants when hydrants are marked for replacement. 134 **Police Department:** Chief Yakopovich – 9-1-1 upgrade was performed today. The Civil Service 135 Commission will be meeting on Monday, September 16 to certify the new patrol officer and dispatch 136 lists. Sgt. Plesz applied for and received a grant just shy of \$31,000 from the Ohio Traffic Safety office to 137 cover saturation of patrols around the holidays to prevent crashes, distracted and impaired driving. 138 139 140 **Law Department**: Director Guidetti – No report. 141 142 **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** None 143 144 **NEW BUSINESS**: None 145 There being no further business, Mr. Garvas moved, second by Ms. Tulley, to adjourn the meeting. CITY OF MACEDONIA RESOLUTION NO. 66 - 2024

A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FULL SIDEWALKS AND OTHERWISE CONFIRMING THE CONDITIONAL ZONING CERTIFICATE AS APPROVED BY THE CITY OF MACEDONIA PLANNING COMMISSION IN REGARD TO THE VALLEY RESERVE SUBDIVISION DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, planned unit developments, a residential use, are considered a permitted use in R-1 residential districts when approved by the City of Macedonia Planning Commission as a conditional use; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has determined a conditional zoning certificate for the Valley Reserve Subdivision development project is proper as a conditional use in a residential district, and therefore approved the same at its July 15, 2024 Planning Commission meeting; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Macedonia Codified Ordinance §§1163.02(a)(5), § 1137.04(e) requires, among other things, that conditional uses approved by the Planning Commission pursuant to Codified Ordinance § 1171.15 (nonresidential uses in residential districts) be confirmed by a majority vote of Council before any building or occupancy permits can be issued; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has further recommended at its July 15, 2024 Planning Commission meeting that the requirement of the construction of full sidewalks be waived, and a minimum of sidewalks on one side of the road be allowed in regard to the Valley Reserve Subdivision, pursuant to Macedonia Codified Ordinance § 1163.05(h)(2); and

WHEREAS, Council therefore wishes to confirm said conditional zoning certificate relative to the Valley Reserve Subdivision planned unit development project, and waive the requirement for the construction of full sidewalks as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Macedonia, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the conditional zoning certificate issued by the Planning Commission is hereby and herein confirmed, contingent upon all recommendations and requirements imposed by the Planning Commission being adhered to, and that the requirement for the construction of full sidewalks be waived, and the requirement for sidewalks for the Valley Reserve Subdivision planned unit development project be modified so as to require the installation of sidewalks on one side on the road, and allowing 7'6" side setbacks (resulting in 15' between buildings) consistent with the Planning Commission's approval, and as set forth in the document attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A."






