 - a. Trails and Dock project Discussions began involving build out options. Director Gigliotti will begin gathering pricing estimates so we can discuss the work and distinguish phases for the build out. We have \$200,000 so far with \$100,000 coming each of the next 3 years plus grant money potential. We will begin pricing out dock options.
 - i. Question from PRC: Can we build a pollinator path through the existing woods and also new areas.
 - ii. Also, one page info about the project and trees.
 - iii. Could these additions be made? Bocce ball, corn holes, horseshoes, or other things.
 - Field C Lighting The project has been approved by Council and is moving forward.
 Parts are ordered and on 16-week lead time. We are working towards a June completion.
