



RESIDENTIAL CULVERT PIPE REQUIREMENTS



REQUIRED:

- 2-1/2" MIN. Compacted Gravel Base Prior to Setting Pipe.
- Culvert Pipe Sloped at ½ to 1 Inch per Foot.
- Compact Suitable Material in 6" Lifts on Either Side of Pipe to Top

RECOMMENDED:

Installation of Headwall or Similar Features at Ends of Culvert Pipe to Prevent Erosion.

NOTES

ALL CONCRETE WORK, WHETHER ORIGINAL INSTALLATION OR REPAIR, OF ANY DRIVEWAY, APRON, CITY WALK, OR COMMERCIAL PROPERTY, SHALL ALSO MEET AND BE GOVERNED BY MACEDONIA RESIDENTIAL DRIVEWAY REQUIREMENTS AND CONCRETE / ASPHALT REQUIREMENTS.

Driveway culvert pipe shall be:

- Corrugated Galvanized Steel **or** High Density Polyethylene (HDP).
- A minimum diameter of twelve (12) inches and minimum length of fourteen (14) feet.
- Installed in the roadway ditch at such line and grade so as not to restrict the flow of water in the roadway ditch.

Please DO NOT purchase a culvert pipe until it is properly sized by the City Engineer.

The following is required for installation of a residential culvert pipe:

- 1. Completed Engineering Permit Application.
- 2. Site plan showing location of concrete work and distances from property lines and/or structures.

INSPECTION REQUIRED:

An inspection is required prior to receipt of concrete or asphalt. Your presence is not required. Please call the Building Department to schedule the inspection.

ALL CONTRACTORS / SUBCONTRACTORS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE CITY PRIOR TO BEGINNING WORK (Codified Ordinance 1361.02)

INSPECTIONS ARE REQUIRED TO BE CALLED IN BY 3:00 P.M. THE DAY BEFORE INSPECTION 330-468-8363 OR 330-468-8364
