Agreement from all but two members. \$2.35 million from covid and \$1.35 from sale of old building. Around \$7 million for new building, 18,000 20,000 sq ft. Future plan to demolish 1 building at a time, Valley View Rd being the first. Sell other properties and keeping portion of Valley View one. New salt dome at park, hidden by building. Loan for a little less than half. Looking to have new driveway going into building.
- b. Overall Updates Longwood in full swing, fields non-stop usage. 2 Parks staff completely doing ballfields all day each day and mowing. Storm water all installed, dugouts all in. Sugarbush extended infield to 80' baseline. Field C mounded pitching now. A/D has temporary fencing now.
