2. Public Comments – no comments
3. Introduction of new member – Jason Hack – Lived in area whole life, Nordonia graduate, worked in parks cutting grass. Graduated Kent State.
4. Health & Safety updates for Parks & Rec
 - a. Parks – Ok, restrooms cleaned daily. During nice weather people are enjoying Parks.
 - b. Recreation – Things are going well as everything transitions inside. Purposely have to keep classes small based on COVID distancing, some angst amongst members wanting to attend classes, investigating hybrid option for in-person/virtual.
 - i. Question - How is air flow working? Air kicked up high for flow and extraction. Check on UV lights. These have been met with mixed reviews.
5. Financials
 - Updates – 2021 budget talks begin tomorrow for next 4-5 weeks. November will have better idea for project money roll over. The \$55,000 P&R will roll over with monies that are left.
 - Parks – Spent additional \$800 from trash containers.
 - Recreation – on track, 60 memberships sold during Oct 5th week sale
 - Anniversary sale – 30 annual, 24 monthly, 6 other discounts = 60 total in a week
6. Project update
 - a. 2nd Floor Carpet Replacement – Starts Friday, October 23 with downstairs aerobics room. Will conclude by next Friday with various areas being shut down one day at a time and equipment relocated.
 - b. Equipment replacement plan – Equipment list is completed, age and hours/mileage denoted for most pieces. Developing a yearly buying plan to retire pieces and get new. Will auction off old pieces.
 - c. Hot tube repair status – We have completed all 3 phases of testing and found multiple leaks, 1 in main drain, multiple in jets. In final quote procurement now and will development timeline with selected company, likely a 6-8-week project.
7. Parks
 - a. Updates on planting of trees, dog clean up stations
 - a. Trees, contractor selected has order, end of month/early Nov. Dog waste and trash can are ordered. Councilmember Garvas did a mapping of trails. Looking to complete some mapping and display some animal life in there. Jeremy asked for mockups to see if PRC can commit some monies to help enhance the educational pieces.

- b. Sugarbush basketball – may look to tear out asphalt and put new and new baskets. Also seeing who is responsible for painting lines. May want to look at cameras for parks.
 - c. Sugarbush Trail – Property lines have not been routed yet, Mayor asked for paperwork. It's been emailed to Mayor according to Staci. Looking to re-route trail as needed.
- b. Update on purchase of 22 new trash bins for the parks - ordered
