311.01 Placing Injurious Material Or Obstruction in Street.

No person shall place any obstruction in or upon a street without proper authority.

521.06 Duty to Keep Sidewalks in Repair and Clean.

No owner or occupant of abutting lands shall fail to keep the sidewalks, <u>curbs</u> or <u>gutters</u> free from any nuisance.

2022 Road Program

The following roads within the City of Macedonia have been completely repaved.

- Capital Boulevard
- Prairie Crossing
- Brook Circle

Highland Road Re-Surfacing

Repaying of Highland Road is now complete. This is the portion of Highland Road between Valley View Road, and Chamberlin Road. The City of Macedonia has received a grant from the Ohio Public Works Commission in the amount of \$415,000, for the re-surfacing of Highland Road.

Windmill Golf Center

The parking lot for the Windmill Golf Center has been completely reconstructed, with new handicap accessible parking spaces.

Golden Link Blvd Re-Surfacing

Re-surfacing of Golden Link Boulevard, with the shopping center, is scheduled to re-surfaced in 2023. The City of Macedonia, in conjunction with our partner Northfield Center Township, has received a grant from the Ohio Public Works Commission in the amount of \$144,500, for the re-surfacing of Golden Link Boulevard.

Notes from your city council...

Council meetings are typically on the 2nd and 4th Thursday of each month, except when meetings are canceled due to holidays. Before each meeting, council has a work session in the caucus room. Council has "office hours" where a council member is available for one-on-one conversation prior to the work session.

At the end of the year, Council will be holding Finance Committee meetings prior to the work session to finalize the 2023 city budget, which will then be read and hopefully approved by the December meeting. Council office hours will be canceled through the end of the year.

Check the city calendar for start times of the council work sessions, Finance Committee meetings and office hours, which will be published within 48 hours of each meeting. Residents are welcome and encouraged to attend work sessions, committee meetings and council meetings!

All meetings are currently being held in person in council chambers, unless council has decided to hold a virtual meeting due to a weather or health emergency. The ability to hold virtual meetings was added to our Charter after a vote in the May 3, 2022 Primary Election.

Residential Fireworks in Ohio

As of July 1, 2022, consumer-grade fireworks are legal to discharge in Ohio on private property on certain days, and with other stipulations (see below). The City of Macedonia has the right to make its own laws regarding fireworks, but as of now Council has decided not to take any action.

That being said, Council is seeking the opinions of residents on the matter. We are asking that residents send their opinions via email to the Council Clerk, Jon Hoover, at jhoover@macedonia.oh.us. The more we hear from residents the better we will be able to make a decision about allowing the discharge of fireworks on certain days to continue.

There have been some misconceptions among residents about the new rules for fireworks in Ohio. Below is some useful information about the laws:

The new laws reply to residential fireworks displays, not commercial.

Commercial fireworks displays from licensed professionals are still allowed within the city and the state, independent of the new laws.

Residential fireworks will be allowed on several days, not just July 4th.

There are approximately 15 to 20 days in the year on which the discharge of fireworks is permitted. The dates allowed are: New Year's Day (Jan 1, until 1 AM), Chinese New Year (one day, in January or February), Cinco de Mayo (May 5), Memorial Day weekend (the last Monday in May, and the Saturday & Sunday preceding), Juneteenth (June 19), July 4th (July 3, 4 and 5, and the Saturdays and Sundays before and after July 4h), Labor Day (the first Monday in September, and the Saturday & Sunday preceding), Diwali (one day, usually in October or November) and New Year's Eve (December 31, through 1 AM on January 1).

There is a set time frame in which you can discharge fireworks.

The time frame is 4PM to 11PM on the days listed, excepting New Year's Eve where fireworks are permitted until 1 AM on New Year's Day.

There is a limit on who can discharge fireworks.

Children under the age of 18 are not permitted to handle or discharge fireworks. Furthermore, those under the influence of alcohol or other controlled substances are not permitted to use fireworks, and may be charged with a misdemeanor if found in violation.

Fireworks must be a safe distance from spectators

Aerial fireworks must be 150 feet away from spectators. Non-aerial fireworks must be at least 50 feet away. Also, when discharging aerial fireworks, children under 18 must be 150 feet away.

Keep your fireworks on your own property

Unless you have permission, fireworks must be discharged from your own property. Also, once it is safe to do so, clean up any debris that lands on the road or other public property. Macedonia Police reported no more calls than usual this July 4th weekend.

According to Chief Jon Golden, call volume wasn't any higher this year than any previous year. With the new Ohio laws in place, it was still a typical July 4th in Macedonia.

Driver Safety Around School Buses



Of all the driver safety guidelines detailed in state driving handbooks, school bus safety may quite possibly be the most important rule that gets constantly overlooked.

School buses are protected incredibly well under U.S. traffic law, and for good reason: we trust these vehicles to transport our kids safely to and from schools. Without proper laws and standards in place to protect school buses, we would be putting children in immense potential harm.

This is especially true during the boarding and offboarding of passengers at bus stops, where the most important school bus safety rule is enforced.

Stop Means Stop!

If a school bus is at a full stop with stop signs out and lights blaring, it means to STOP! This is the most crucial point in school bus safety, as kids are exiting and entering the bus, and they may not be aware of other vehicles on the road. When even adults have issues with looking both ways before crossing the street, it's no surprise that children have problems remembering that as well.

The laws around school bus stops are generally the same throughout the nation. If you're on the same side of the road as the bus in a residential or non-highway area, there are no exceptions – you MUST stop if the bus stops, and resume moving when the bus deems it appropriate.



Fall is just around the corner and the Department of Public Service will soon be heading into leaf season. Leaf season has always been my favorite time of year—probably because the weather is perfect, and the leaves are beautiful. There are a few things to keep in mind as we put our leaves to the curb. Always keep the leaves out of storm drains and out of the curb gutter. Fall can also be a rainy time of year, and we always want to avoid flooding. It is acceptable to keep leaves in the tree lawn—the area between the curb and the sidewalk. Storing leaves on the grass for a short time, even up to a few weeks, will not kill the grass. The grass may look somewhat discolored, but the color will come back quickly. Please do not park cars in front of leaf piles, and always be careful as you pass our leaf crews on the road. Always check the Macedonia website for updates on dates for leaf season and any other Public Service information.

The Department of Public Service has also been working diligently on building a new bathroom at Veterans Memorial Park. Along with the hard work of the Veterans, great progress has been made. If you have time, swing by the park, and take a look at the new building. It is very exciting, and this will be a wonderful addition to our community.

Snow season is also around the corner and will be here before we know it. As always there are a few reminders when it comes to plowing. Always be cautious driving around snowplow trucks, it is often difficult for them to see you. Stay back and give your snowplow driver at least 100 feet of room. Check your mailbox and make sure it is sturdy and in working order. Oftentimes, snow is heavy and can impact mailboxes.
